The 2008's Quality score is very promising. Jancis Robinson's rating suggests that it is amongst the best of the last ten vintages, beaten only by the 1996 (991 points).

The 2008 release price of £46 is similar to the market price of the most recent five vintages, and over £25 less than the 1993 and 1995 vintages which achieved similar Quality scores.
