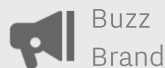

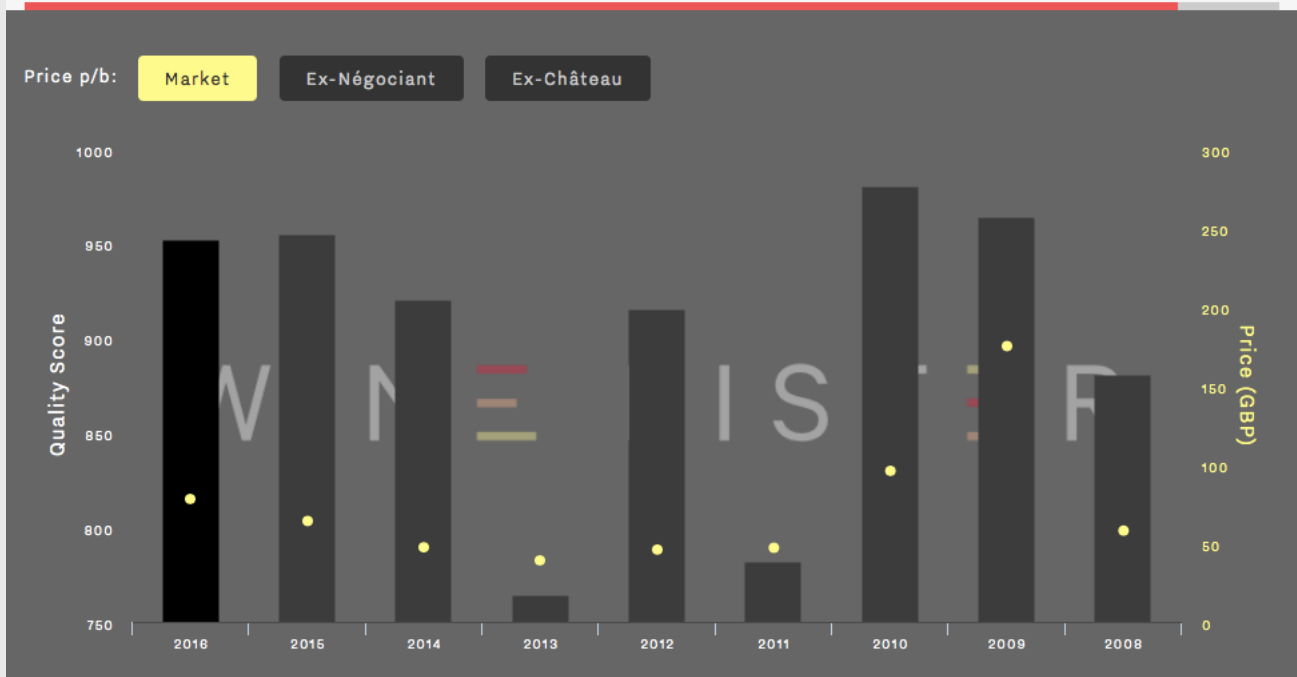

Smith Haut Lafitte 2016: Quality score vs price per bottle (£)

2016's ex-négociant release price is the highest since 2010, and the UK RRP is up a bold 50% up on 2015, but remains well below the current market price of 2009 and 2010 (although it doesn't quite attain the same WL Quality score). Speculative comparison to 2010 might just support this price given the superb quality of the 2016 and the upward trajectory of the brand. One to follow closely.
