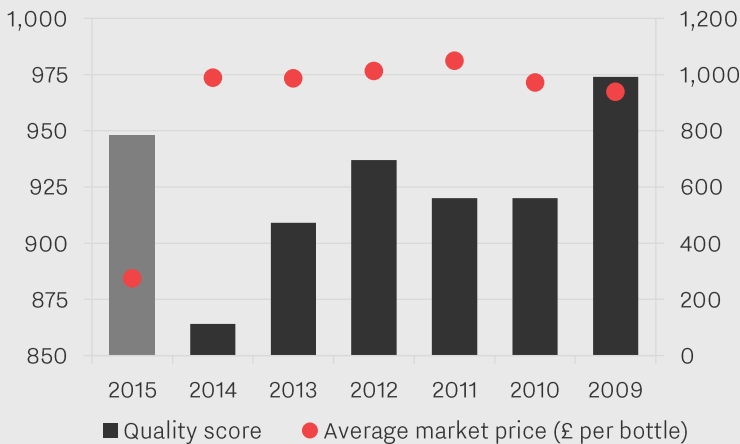

The 2015 achieves DRC Corton's second-best Quality score in its short history. Its release price (£275) puts it at a 72% discount to any other Corton on the market. As with all DRC wines, getting an allocation is the issue.
