Haut-Batailley 2017: price analysis¹

A price increase of 46% on the 2015 release, putting the 2017 well above any vintage currently in the market, sends a strong message that Haut-Batailley's new owners, the Cazes family, have big plans for the brand. This bold repositioning catapults the wine into the next price tier and makes it a contender as a "flying fifth", if it works.

Château Haut-Batailley Cinquième Cru




