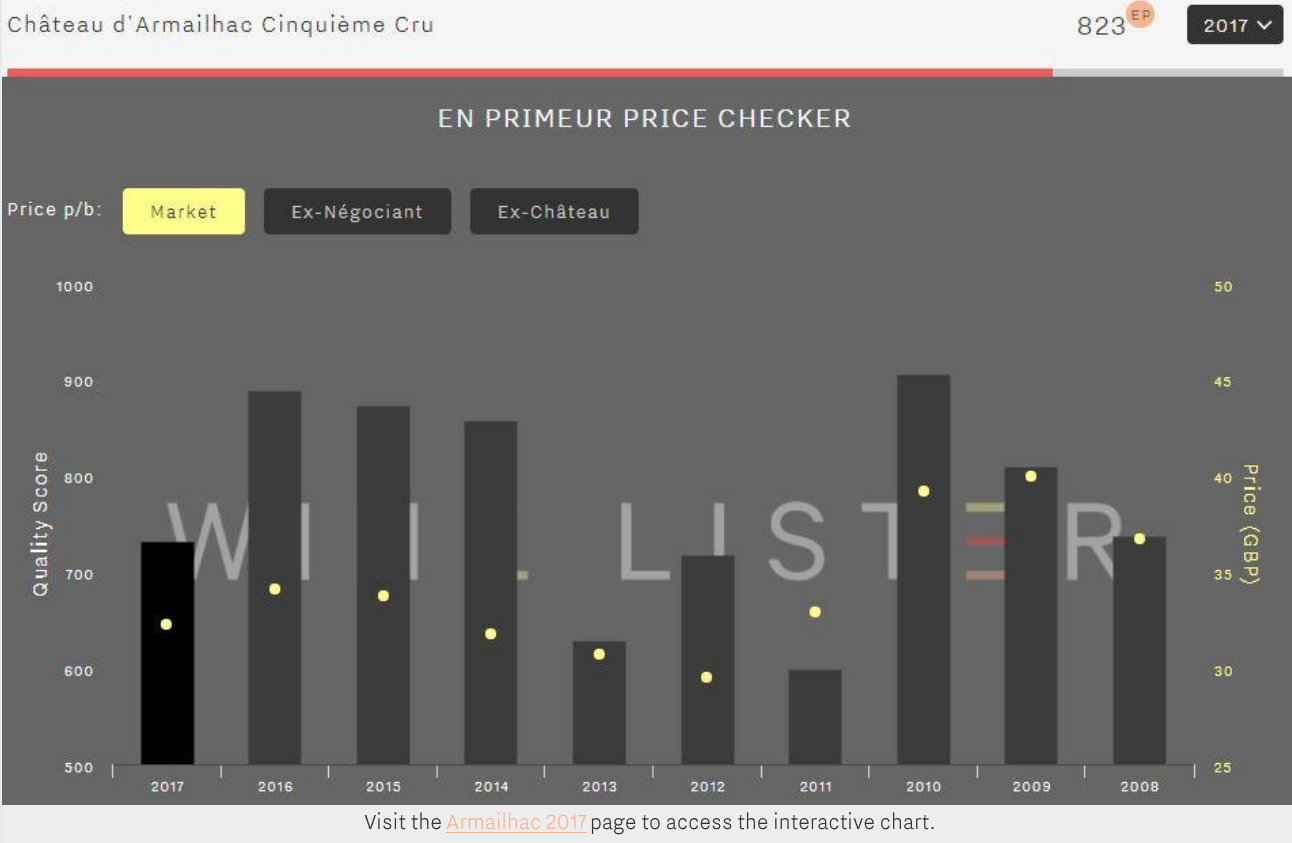

D'Armailhac's RRP puts it below current market prices for 2015 and 2016 but above the higher-scoring 2014, making the case for buying 2017 en primeur less than clear cut. Volume released is down 20% on last year.
