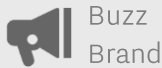

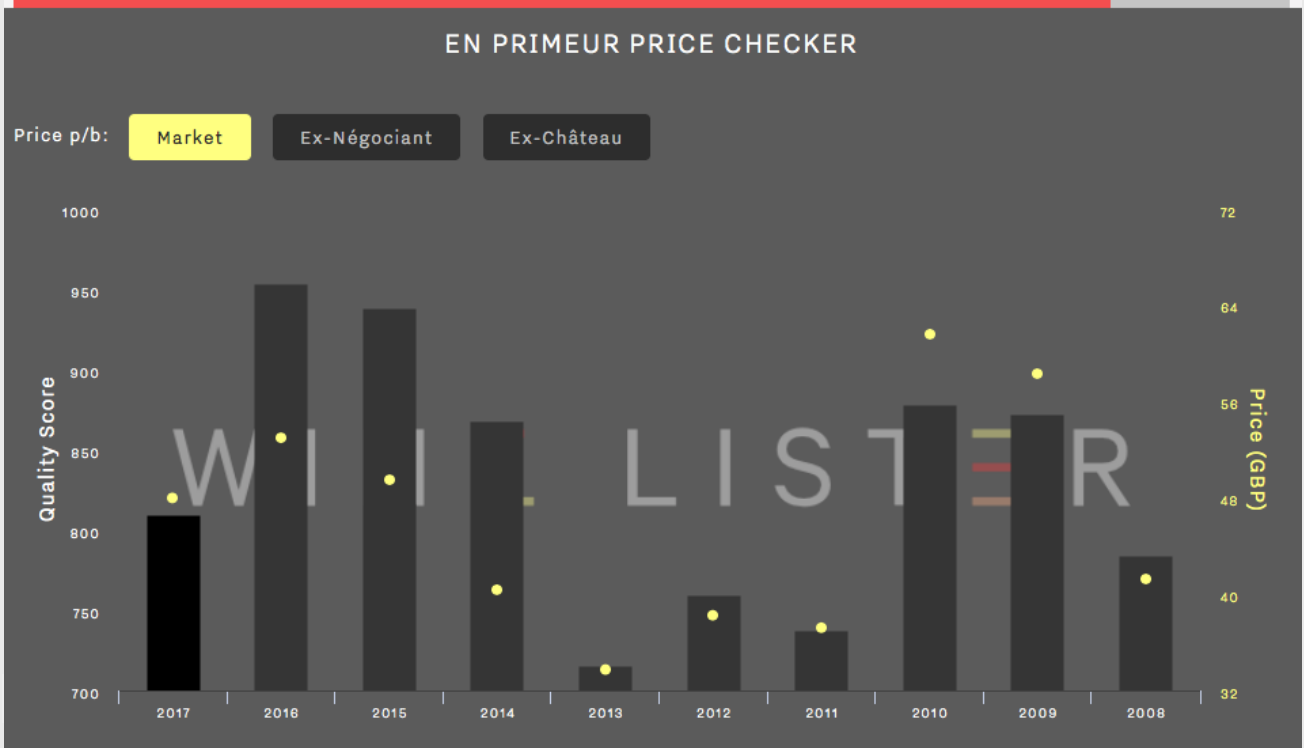

Brane-Cantenac 2017: Quality score vs average market price (£)

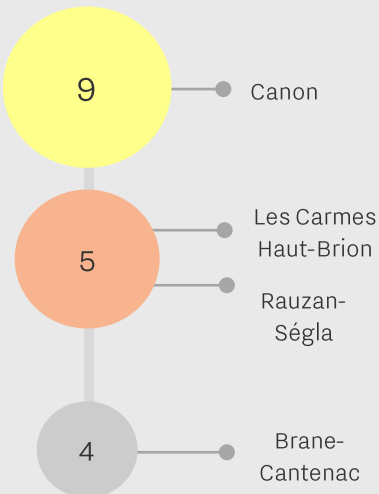
