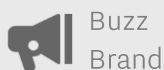

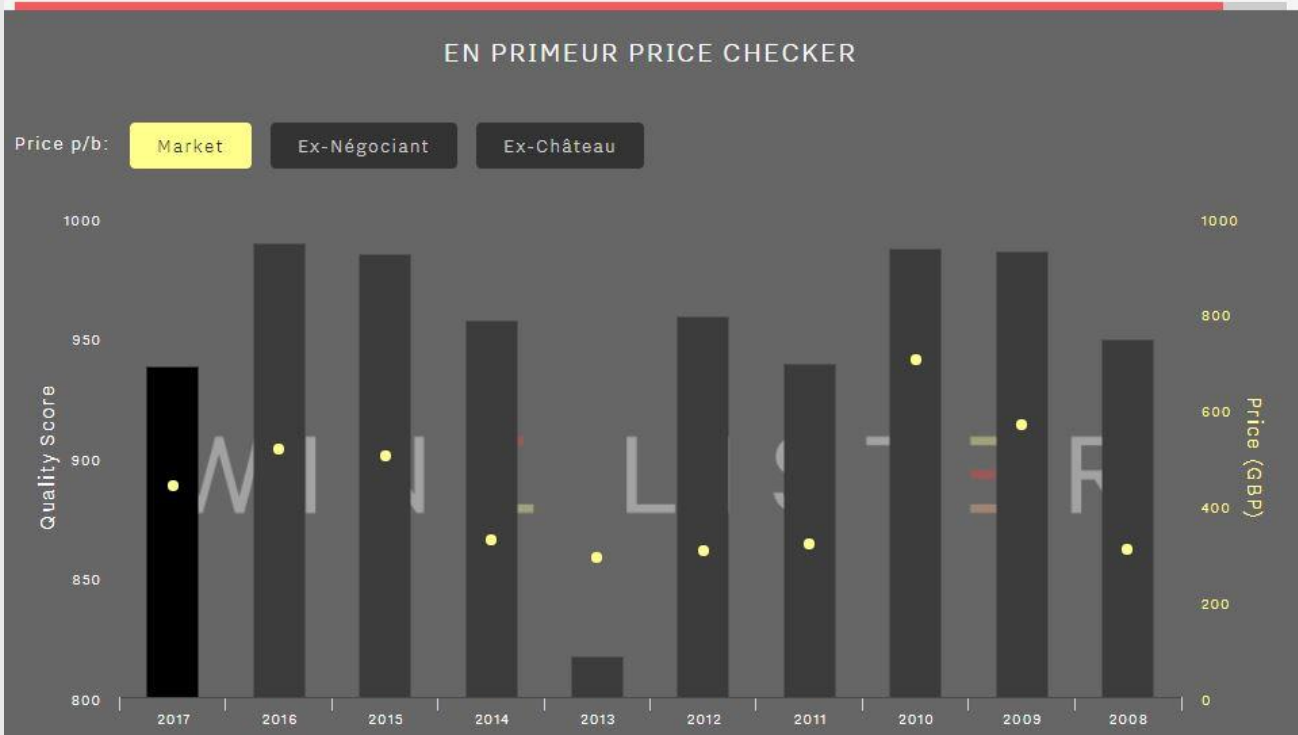
Cheval Blanc 2017: Quality score vs average market price (£)

Cheval Blanc has made the right noises releasing its 2017 with a hefty year-on-year decrease. However, given post-release performance of the 2016, this doesn't translate into an equally large discount to the current market price. Other vintages look attractive by comparison, but rarity comes into play here too, with only one third the usual amount available, due to frost.
