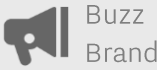




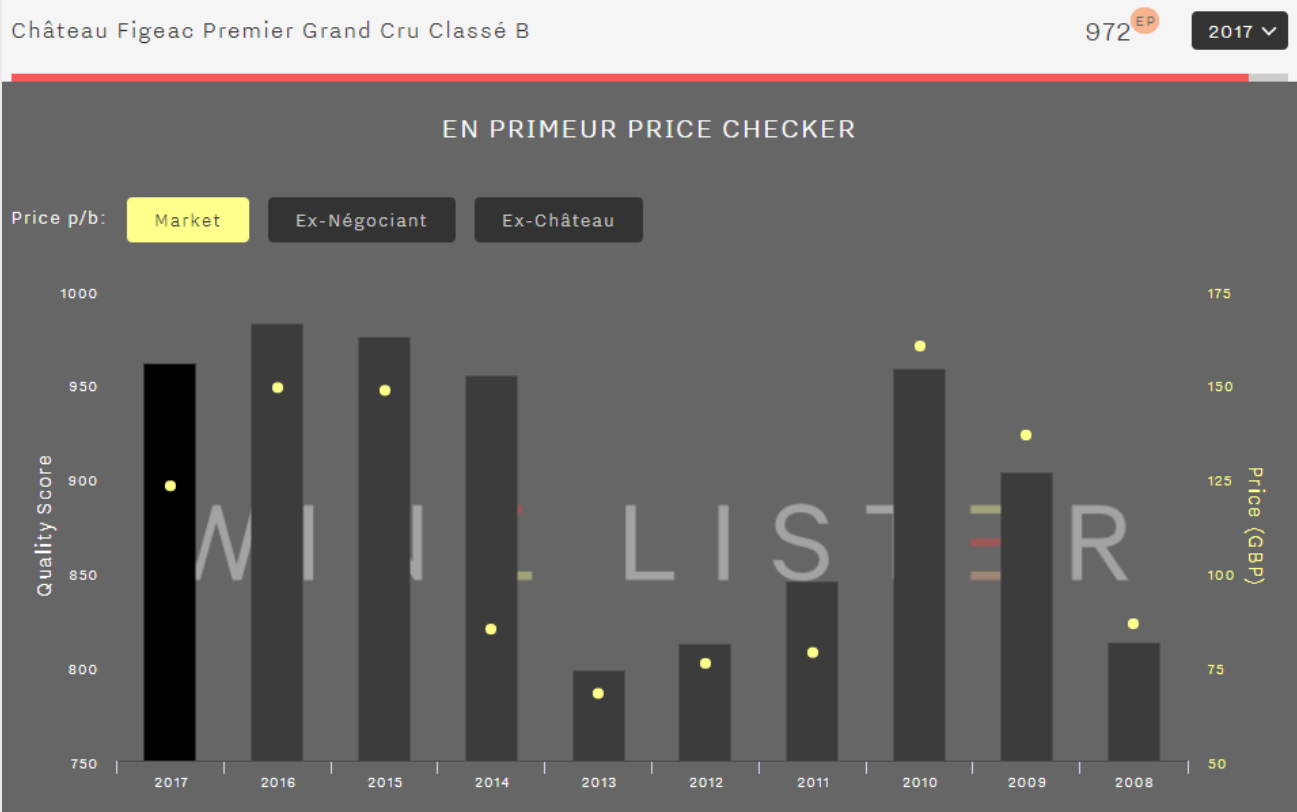

Figeac's 2017 is not far off the exceptional 2015 and 2016 in quality terms. With the château's star in the ascendancy, and its success *en primeur* last year, this 2017's 20% discount year-on-year should spark sufficient interest to carry it through while cementing last year's significant repositioning exercise. The only fly in the ointment, once again, is the significantly cheaper 2014.

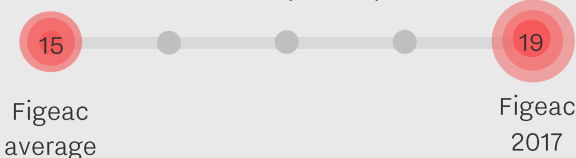
