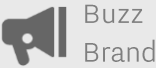

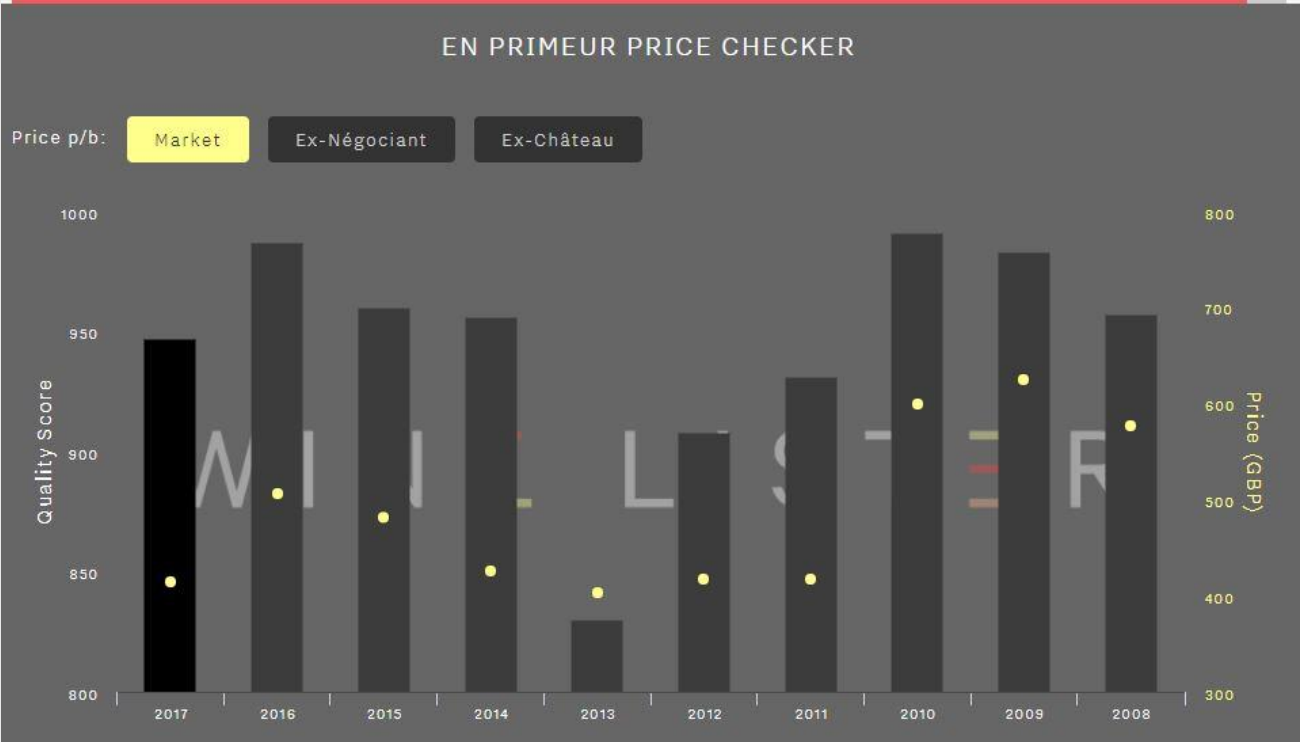

Lafite 2017: Quality score vs average market price (£)

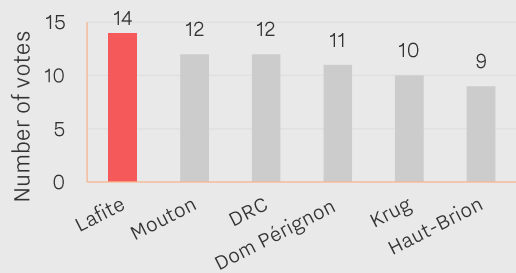
Lafite 2017 is being offered in the UK at £415 per bottle, which puts it into market at a similar price to the lower-rated 2011 and 2012, above the 2013, but below all other recent vintages. Given the wine's imperious performance in last year's campaign, and in general, there should be strong demand at this price, despite being at the tail end of a lacklustre campaign.
