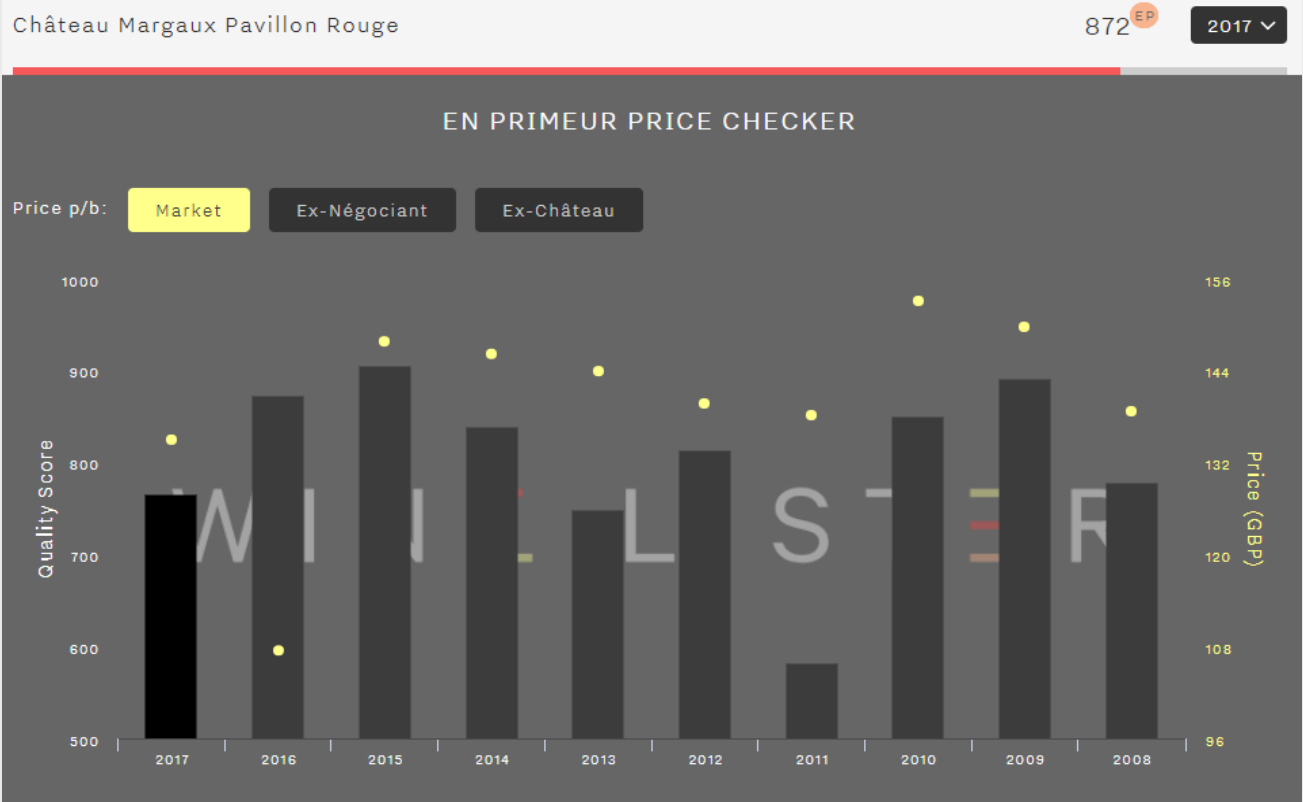

Pavillon Rouge 2017: Quality score vs average market price (£)

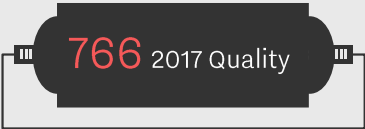
A significant price increase this year sees Château Margaux reclaiming healthy margins historically guaranteed to trade and consumers on purchasing its second wine *en primeur*. Nonetheless, it probably still makes sense to buy the wine now given its track record of increasing in price once physically available.

Pavillon Rouge's confidence rating has improved one point since last year's Wine Lister's Founding Members survey and now is 8/10. It is the only first growth's second wine to achieve this rating.
