

“Seña has been on a steady upward quality curve since its first vintage in 1995. Moreover it has gradually found its true Chilean identity, with balanced, complex wines that are much more than just Bordeaux copies or wannabes. 2017 was a warm, early vintage, and the ‘smallest ever’ according to winemaker Francisco Baettig, so we expect release volumes to be down.”

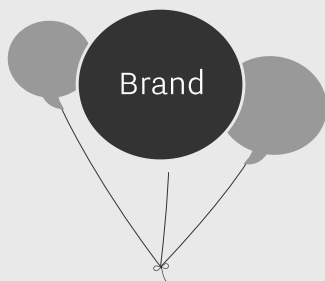

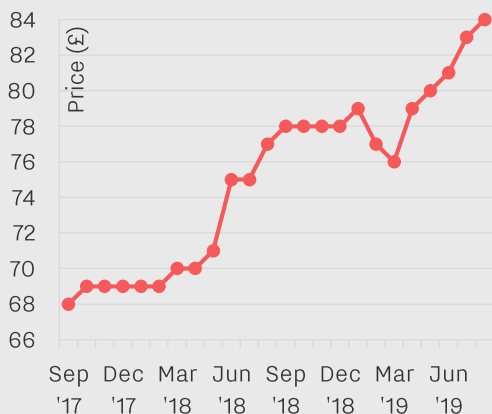


PRICE PERFORMANCE
