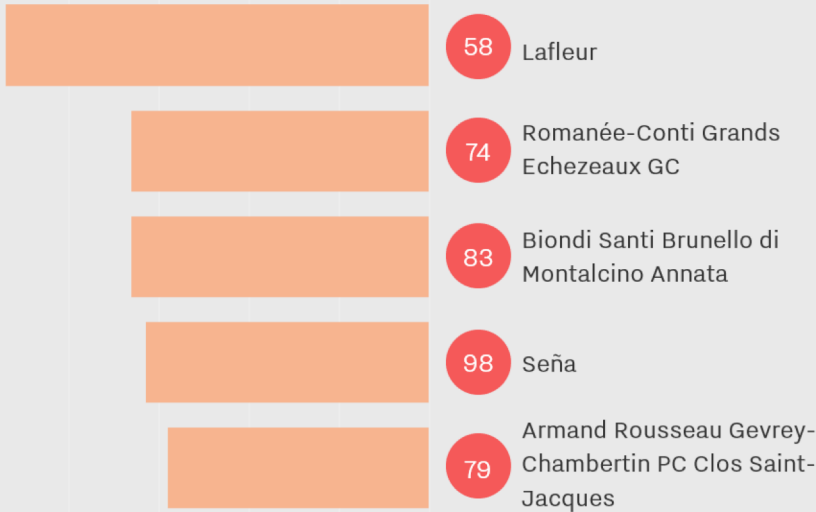

Search rank | Top five biggest movers in 2022

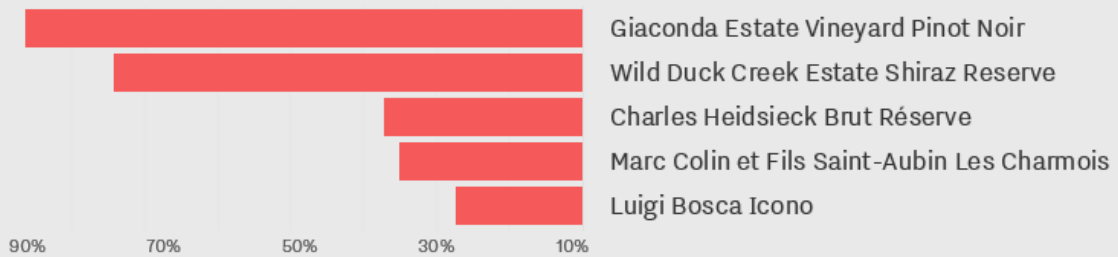
PLACES MOVED NOV 2022 SEARCH RANK



Using monthly search data from Wine-Searcher, we present the wines that have seen the largest increase in their search rank between December 2020 and November 2022. Lafleur sees the largest increase, followed by Romanée-Conti Grands Eschezeaux GC and Biondi Santi Brunello di Montalcino Annata. Mouton remains the #1 most popular wine in 2022, followed by Petrus and Dom Pérignon. Below, we present the five wines whose Wine Lister Quality scores have improved most since 2020. Australia takes three spots on this year’s list of 20 top-performing wines.

Upon asking the trade which wines they would include in their dream cellar, these 10 wines received the most mentions (out of 390 wines cited). Latour was referenced 14 times, half of which were specific to the 1961 vintage – which was also the most-cited Bordeaux vintage, followed by 1947. Bordeaux wines remain most popular, accounting for 35% of all wines mentioned.

We also asked the trade to name the most memorable wines they tasted in 2022 - Haut-Brion received the most mentions, followed by Jean-Louis Chave Hermitage, and Rayas Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
